

Day 2 **Copenhagen – Åhus** **(B/L/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel and check out

Travel across the Öresund Bridge

The bridge connects Sweden and Denmark, and it is the longest road and rail bridge in Europe. The bridge was built 1995-2000. It is 7,8 km long, but there is also the man-made island Pepparholm and a tunnel from the Danish side. The total length of the bridge is 15,8 km.

You will discover the most southern part of Sweden with the best arable land and a mix of large Estates with 1000 of hectares and smaller family farms with a couple of 100.

Visit to a grain farm who focus on **oilseed and the production of rape seed oil** for a large scale market.

Visit the landmark Ale Stenar, the largest stone setting in the Nordic countries and enjoy a fish lunch in the small village

Visit to an apple plantation

Hear about fruit production in Sweden in the most fruit and apple productive area

Travelling along the picturesque coastline you will end at the east coast of Skåne at the beach resort Åhus.

Dinner at hotel by the beach

Visit to the Center of Absolut Vodka to experience the fantastic story of Absolut Vodka which is produced in the village of Åhus.

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out

We will travel north leaving the open landscape to the forest and lake district of region Småland with its typical Swedish red cottages.

The day starts with a visit to a larger potato- or vegetable grower

You will follow the coast line and make a stop by “Mörrumsån”, where masses of salmon make their way out to the sea. Possible to learn about the salmon breeding and work to keep the fish population healthy

Region Småland is known for its history of glass blowing, still a couple of smaller glassworks are active

Visit to the glass factory and shop

Here the place name is derived from the glassworks with the little blowing room. The village, you see, bears the official name of Boda Glasbruk. Nowadays Boda is part of the Kosta Boda brand. In the area many of the old works buildings still remain. In the shop you can bargain hunt for Kosta Boda products at factory prices.

Lunch

Continue to the town Växjö

Visit to a forestowner and the company Södra, one of the larger forest companies in the world. The visit can take place at the head office or in the

Possible visit to **De Laval**, world leading producer of dairy production equipment.

Lunch

Arrival to Stockholm and check in to hotel

Stockholm is generally referred to as Beauty on Water, or Venice of the North, which is understandable, as the city is built upon 14 islands. It is surrounded by Lake Mälaren, and by the Baltic Sea. The mixture of old and new, greenery and water, picturesque narrow streets and engaging modern broad ones provides an attractiveness you rarely meet elsewhere.

Visit to the Vasa ship museum

Sightseeing with your guide at the museum where you see the amazing warship built to show the power of Sweden in the 17th century. The ship sunk on when leaving Stockholm on her maiden voyage in 1628. She was brought up to land 1961 and restored. Today the Vasaship is a worldwide sensation in her museum.

Absolute Icebar

An Aperitif will be served at where you will get equipped in a warming coat before getting the drink in your glass made of ice.

Continue to the old town where you will be served your farwell dinner in a historical restaurant
